The Art Show Committee requests that artists show work not previously exhibited in our annual show.

- All artists must be current ASC members and may exhibit one or two pieces. Much of our exhibit will be wall-hung, but there is space for installations and 3-dimensional work. Please let us know if you have any unusual display requirements.
- 2. Each artist must sign a waiver for loss or damage liability. Artwork may be listed for sale with the proceeds divided as follows: Artist 80%; Northeast Harbor Library 20%. If work is for sale, please include the price; if not, please indicate that the work is not for sale.
- 3. Each artist must submit an <u>Artists Agreement Form</u> by <u>Friday, April 28<sup>th</sup>.</u>
- 4. **Hanging Guidelines**: The Art Show Committee strongly discourages zigzag hangers, and suggests that wire hangers are measured so they hang 1/3 of the way down the frame and are NOT seen above the frame when hung. The hanging system at the Library also does not work well with lightweight pieces such as photographs printed on aluminum.

**Drop off time at NEH Library**: Please bring all artwork to the front desk of the library during the week of April 24 – 29. Artwork must be ready to hang or display.
